Beyond the competition at AT&T Park, our volunteering efforts will stretch across various locations such as hotels, training facilities, and transportation hubs with roles such as Bay Area Ambassadors, Rugby Geniuses and support for Media, Production & Operations teams.

Volunteer Role Requirements:

- Must be knowledgeable about Bay Area (exception of specialized competition roles)
- Guest service oriented
- Willingness to help
- Must be 18 years of age

Time Commitment for Volunteers:

- A minimum of (4) six to eight-hour shifts is required to be a volunteer. If you cannot commit to the minimum number of shifts, you will not be able to volunteer for Rugby World Cup Sevens 2018
- Volunteer positions for tournament week will begin as early as Monday, July 16, 2018, and complete as late as Wednesday, July 25, 2018. Selection & Training of Volunteers:

- Applications are currently open online at rwcsevens.com/volunteer
- After you apply, you will be notified by email in early 2018 about how to sign up for your interview
- After the interview session, all selected volunteers will be notified by email. You will be required to attend an orientation session in Spring 2018 and role-specific training in June/July 2018. If you are selected for a lead volunteer role, you may be asked to attend additional training as well
